
ADDING SSL EXCEPTIONS

This Connection is Untrusted

Lumen Software includes a Self Signed SSL Certificate with your local server. First login to the server will present the user with the "This Connection is Untrusted" error message.

Firefox provides this error as a courtesy to help protect users from malicious sites. To prevent this error message from being displayed either a CA Signed SSL Certificate should be installed, or a SSL Exception added to the browers.

Below are the instructions for adding the SSL Exception:

You have asked Firefox to connect securely to **Your Local Server**, but we can't confirm that your connection is secure

Normally, when you try to connect securely, sites will present trusted identification to prove that you are going to the right place. However, this site's identity can't be verified.

What Should I Do?

If you usually connect to this site without problems, this error could mean that someone is trying to impersonate the site, and you shouldn't continue.

Technical Details

▼ I Understand the Risks

If you understand what's going on, you can tell Firefox to start trusting this site's identification. **Even if** you trust the site, this error could mean that someone is tampering with your connection.

Don't add an exception unless you know there's a good reason why this site doesn't use trusted identification.
