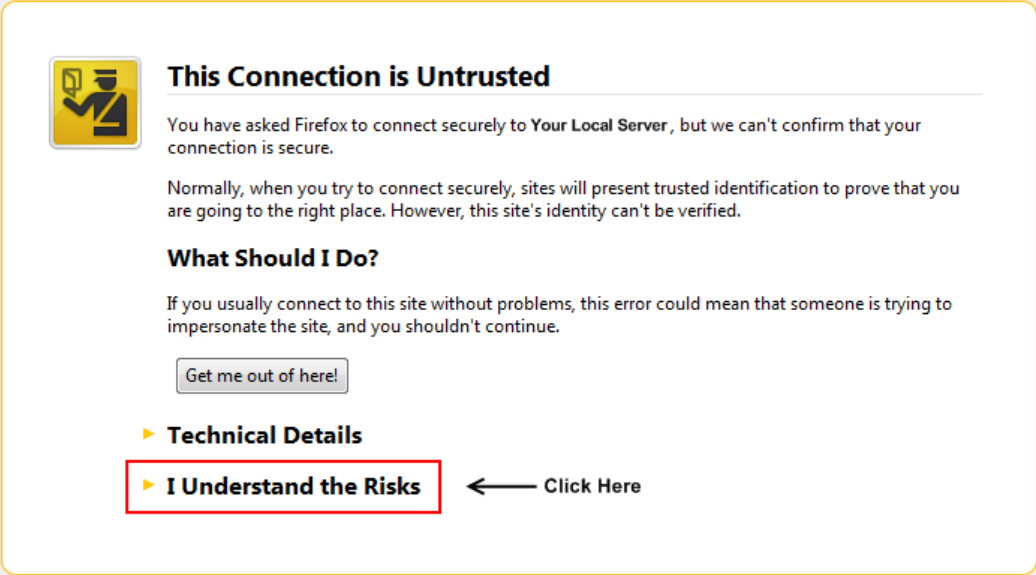
ADDING SSL EXCEPTIONS

This Connection is Untrusted

Lumen Software includes a Self Signed SSL Certificate with your local server. First login to the server will present the user with the “This Connection is Untrusted” error message.

Firefox provides this error as a courtesy to help protect users from malicious sites. To prevent this error message from being displayed either a CA Signed SSL Certificate should be installed, or a SSL Exception added to the browsers.

Below are the instructions for adding the SSL Exception:
