Parents and Guardians,

We would like to update you on some of the services we will be providing during our closure through Friday, April 3rd .

Beginning Monday, March 23, we will be making meals available for any child 18 years of age and younger in our district. These meals are available in two ways:

1. **Drive Through Pickup** - Parents, guardians, or students can pick up meals at the high school front entrance on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00-11:00 AM. Traffic will enter the West side of the parking lot and drive East, towards the preschool in front of the High School for meal pickup.
2. **Summer School Bus Routes**- We will be delivering meals on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday for those who have indicated on the district survey that they need this service. The buses will leave the high school at 9:00 AM and will stop to deliver meals at normal Summer School bus stops. Please be at your stop if you have chosen to receive this delivery method. Bus drivers will be in contact with families regarding bus stop times.

Beginning on Wednesday, March 25, academic resources and materials will be made available. Parents, guardians, or students can get these resources between 9:00-1:00 at the elementary and high school offices. We will also deliver resources using the Summer School Routes listed above. The library in each building will also be open during this time, but we are only going to allow 10 people in each library at a time.

As a reminder, we are asking all parents/guardians to respond to the survey available on our school website (www.gainesvillebulldogs.com) or the school Facebook page. If you are unable to access the survey or have issues with the survey, you can call 679-4200.

We will continue to work with state and local health officials as we make decisions for our students and staff. We will send out updates as we have new information, and adjustments are necessary. We appreciate your understanding and support as we navigate these circumstances.
